

# Prototyping







- What vocabulary should I pre-teach to ensure students will grasp the concepts in this unit?
  - Activities to introduce essential vocabulary using everyday language, AI generated visuals, & examples.
- What review strategies would help students master this vocabulary?
  - Ways to build-in evidence-based review practices and formative assessments throughout the unit.
- How might I break up this material in smaller chunks?
  - Strategies for chunking based on differentiation needs.

## **AI Writing Prompts**

- What are some low-stakes strategies I can use to assess students during the "we do" stage?
  - Providing step-by-step instructions for group activities and guiding questions to keep groups on track.
- What scaffolds in independent writing will support students after I determine differentiated groups?
  - o Checklists and Templates for students to self-assess and monitor progress.
- What are some "real-world" writing activities I could assign for students to apply their learning?
  - Formative assessment projects that engage students while they apply the unit skills.

## Additional Prototyping with AI in Writing

- Using AI to create writing exemplars based on rubrics
- Brainstorming multiple feedback loops based on needs and create scaffolding ideas
- Uploading samples to determine patterns in writing (paid version)
- Using AI to create
   Pre-Assessments and Review

- Teacher using to improve writing samples and then give feedback
- AI generated conversations with historical figures/characters for perspective and point of view
- Generate lists of sentence starters, word banks, transition phrases
- Creating checklists and templates for self-assessment
